**Airport Transportation:** consider coming into the city from the airport by taking the Blue Line (or Market–Frankford Line) elevated train. It costs only \$2.00 while a cab costs about \$28.00. Take the Blue Line to Suburban Station at 15th Street. When you get to the street, walk through "Love Park" (honestly) to Benjamin Franklin Parkway and then walk two blocks west to the hotel. The Blue Line leaves frequently and is clearly marked in the airport.
