Dr. David Grossman is internationally known for his wide-ranging record of research and scholarship that includes citizenship education; global, comparative and intercultural education; teacher education; and social studies education in pedagogy. He is currently a Senior Adjunct Fellow at the East-West Center in Honolulu. Previously he served as Dean of the Faculty of Languages, Arts and Sciences at the Hong Kong Institute of Education (HKIEd), and Dean of the Education Division of Chaminade University of Honolulu. Earlier in his career he served on the faculty of the School of Education at Stanford University, where he founded and served as the Director of the Stanford University Program on International and Cross-Cultural Education (SPICE).
