In 1964, Eiji Kobayashi was granted the EWC scholarship to pursue his MA in Asian studies. In 1968, he was recruited by the Asian Development Bank as an economist. He was the first EWC grantee who joined the bank. He retired in 1994 as Chief Representative, Indonesia Resident Office after working for 26 years. After returning to Japan & for the next ten years, he served as professor at three universities (Kochi, Fuji and Shimonoseki). He was also an exchange scholar at sister universities in China and Korea.
