Ted Lee graduated from Harvard, served in the army in Europe & later attended law school at U.C. Berkeley. In 1962 Ted was asked to join the Center's new Institute of Advanced Projects as Assistant to Vice-Chancellor Ed Weidner. At EWC he co-coordinated many of the Center's first conferences & seminars & drew up documents that established the Friends of EWC. Lee left the Center in 1964 for a long career in urban renewal which included work in San Francisco's Japan Town. He now owns several Nevada casinos. Lee and his wife are strong supporters of education, having served on several university boards. He served on the East-West Center Board of Governors from 2007 to 2011 and the East-West Center Foundation Board of Directors from 2006 to 2012.
