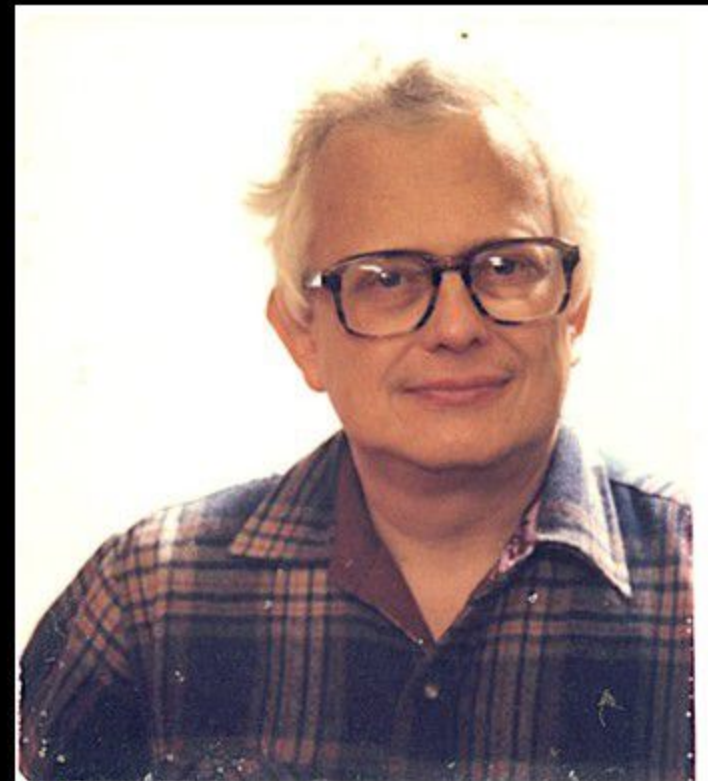


# David J. Radel

1970s Alumnus

David J. Radel, was a Researcher (1971-78) at the East-West Center (EWC)'s Communication Institute, and heading the Inventory-Analysis Project on Information, Education & Communication (IEC) Needs in Population/Family Planning programs worldwide. The project created an Info. Clearing House and served as Information/Knowledge "Broker", matching Countries' IEC Needs with International Development Agencies' assistance/aids. He left EWC and joined the World Bank, in Washington DC, in 1978, serving in the Population and Health Division until his retirement in 1997. There he pioneered the integration of nutrition & population program initiatives in Thailand, creating a widely appreciated and replicated model. His career at the World Bank as a Senior Population and Health Specialist included projects across West Africa, particularly Nigeria.

Dr. Radel (BA, Harvard, 1961; MA, 1967 & Ph.D., 1971, Sociology, Univ. of Minnesota) also served the Ford Foundation in Kenya (1968-71). He passed away in 2005, following years spent traveling with his wife, Ingeborg S. Radel, in pursuit of his other passion, wildflower photography.
